## **Additional Conditions**

### **A. Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974**

1. Industry shall operate and maintain the effluent treatment plant regularly and ensure the treated effluent quality within prescribed standards all the time. Industry shall not discharge effluent outside the premises in any circumstances. Zero discharge condition shall be maintained all the time.
2. Industry shall make arrangements like installation of digital water meter, appraisal report, reuse of non potable water etc. as per NGT order dated 15/11/2022 on OA no. 392/2022 for use of water.
3. Industry shall submit third party report of verification of compliance of condition mentioned in Environmental Clearance/ CTE/ CTO every year.
4. Industry shall submit performance test of all pollution control equipments report carried out by NIT, IIT, (IoR) every year.
5. All the internal roads shall be maintained pucca. Roads shall be cleaned regularly, dust, muck and sludge collected from roads shall be disposed properly.
6. Industry shall comply the provisions of notification (as amended up to date) issued by MoEF&CC for power plant regarding specific water consumptions.
7. Industry shall ensure 100% utilization of fly ash as per provisions of notification dated 31.12.2021 (as amended upto date) issued by MoEF & CC regarding utilization of fly ash.
8. Industry shall ensure the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, inter-alia, mandated banning of identified Single use Plastic (SUP) items with effect from 01/07/2022, CPCB provided the technical guidelines issued by the CPCB in this regard is available at <https://cpcb.nic.in/technical-guidelines-3/> to sensitize and create awareness among people working within the Project area as well as its surrounding area on the ban of SUP in order to ensure the compliance of Notification published by this Ministry on 12/08/2021. A report, along with photographs, on the measures taken shall also be included in the compliance report being submitted by the industry at the time of next renewal application.
9. Industry shall comply with the provision of the notification dated 21/05/2020 issued by MoEF&CC regarding use of coal.
10. Industry shall provide adequate arrangement for proper, safe and scientific storage, handling and disposal etc. of all solid wastes i.e. slag, ESP dust, char, dolochar etc. generated.
11. Industry shall comply with the provision of Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans Boundary Movement) Rules, 2016 (as amended upto date) from the Board and comply with the rule.
12. Industry shall ensure transportation of raw materials / waste by properly covered vehicles. Vehicles used for transporting the wastes / sludge shall be covered with tarpaulins and optimally loaded. Vehicular emissions shall

be kept under control and regularly monitored. Industry shall also ensure use of mechanically covered vehicles after 12/07/2026 for transportation of raw materials, fuel, dust generating products.

13. Industry shall enhance the capacity of rainwater harvesting system to increase the ground water recharge. Industry shall develop rainwater-harvesting structures to harvest the rainwater for utilization in the lean season as well as to recharge the ground water table.
14. Extension in tree plantation shall be carried out in the open areas available within and around the plant premises during monsoon season. Fruit bearing species like mango, tamarind, guava etc. shall be given preference in this regard.
15. This renewal of consent is being issued under the "Scheme of Auto-Renewal of Consent" of the Board issued vide office order no. 5937 dated 29/01/2018 as per self certificate submitted by authorized signatory Mr. Harbilas Agrawal, Director of M/s Shree Rupanadham Steel Private Limited, Village - Saraipali, Tehsil-Tamnar, District - Raigarh (C.G.).
16. In case, if the capital investment is increased by such amount that the total investment exceeds the range for which renewal fees has been paid, the industry shall have to pay the difference amount of renewal fees for the corresponding block years.
17. In case, the prescribed fee payable is amended in future, the industry shall be liable to pay the difference amount for corresponding block years.
18. Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board reserves the rights to revoke the consent / renewal of consent at any time for any violation/non-compliance.

#### **B. Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981**

1. Industry shall operate and maintain the existing air pollution control equipments regularly and effectively so as to ensure the particulate matter emission level below 30 mg/Nm<sup>3</sup>. Emission of air pollutants and ambient air quality shall be ensured within the limits prescribed by Board all the time. Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board may further stipulate stringent particulate matter emission limit depending upon environmental conditions.
2. Calibration and data validation shall be carried out of all CEMS, CAAQMS and industry shall ensure availability or real time data in CPCB/CECB server.
3. Industry shall comply with the emission norms for SO<sub>2</sub> and NO<sub>x</sub> within time limit as prescribed by MoEF & CC/CPCB.
4. Ambient air quality within industry premises shall be kept within latest prescribed standards.
5. Industry shall submit third party report of verification of compliance of condition mentioned in Environmental Clearance/ CTE/ CTO every year.

6. Industry shall submit performance test of all pollution control equipments report carried out by NIT, IIT, (IoR) every year.
7. All the internal roads shall be maintained pucca. Roads shall be cleaned regularly, dust, muck and sludge collected from roads shall be disposed properly.
8. Industry shall provide adequate arrangement for proper, safe and scientific storage, handling and disposal etc. of all solid wastes i.e. dust, fines, char, dolochar etc. generated.
9. Industry shall comply with notification dated 07/12/2015 (as amended up to date) issued by MoEF & CC for power plant regarding gaseous emission.
10. Industry shall ensure 100% utilization of fly ash as per provisions of notification dated 31.12.2021 (as amended upto date) issued by MoEF & CC regarding utilization of fly ash.
11. Industry shall comply with the provision of the notification dated 21/05/2020 issued by MoEF & CC regarding use of coal.
12. Industry shall ensure the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, inter-alia, mandated banning of identified Single use Plastic (SUP) items with effect from 01/07/2022, CPCB provided the technical guidelines issued by the CPCB in this regard is available at <https://cpcb.nic.in/technical-guidelines-3/> to sensitize and create awareness among people working within the Project area as well as its surrounding area on the ban of SUP in order to ensure the compliance of Notification published by this Ministry on 12/08/2021. A report, along with photographs, on the measures taken shall also be included in the compliance report being submitted by the industry at the time of next renewal application.
13. Industry shall ensure transportation of raw materials / waste by properly covered vehicles. Vehicles used for transporting the wastes / sludge shall be covered with tarpaulins and optimally loaded. Vehicular emissions shall be kept under control and regularly monitored. Industry shall also ensure use of mechanically covered vehicles after 12/07/2026 for transportation of raw materials, fuel, dust generating products.
14. Industry shall obtain letter of authorization under Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Trans Boundary Movement) Rules, 2016 (as amended upto date) from the Board and comply with the rule.
15. Extension in tree plantation shall be carried out in the open areas available within and around the plant premises during monsoon season. Fruit bearing species like mango, tamarind, guava etc. shall be given preference in this regard.
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19. Chhattisgarh Environment Conservation Board reserves the rights to revoke the consent / renewal of consent at any time for any violation/non-compliance.
